Our company, "Knights Solution," is seeking the funds to build an infant car seat that will save lives and make everyday living less stressful. Our product is a sensor system, located in the base of the car seat, which is hardwired into the vehicle's computer system. The sensor will be weight sensitive so that when the car is turned off for two minutes, the process chip in the vehicle will turn on the car lights, ignition, air conditioning, and alarm system drawing attention to the forgotten baby. In addition to the vehicle's alert system, Bluetooth technology will also be built into the seat. This component will connect to the parent's cell phone and display a notification when the car is turned off and the weight sensor is still activated.

Given enough funding, the ergonomics of the infant car seat will be factored into the design. The base of the car seat will be able to swivel to ease the securing and removing process. This will alleviate improper buckling to keep the child safe and also make parents more apt to take their child into the store with them instead of leaving them for a few crucial minutes due of the "hassle" of removing and securing them.
